Warning

- **♦** Please read carefully and familiarize yourself with the contents of the manual before using the floor scrubber.
- **♦** This floor scrubber is only used for hard ground. If it is used for other purposes beyond the instructions in this manual, we will not bear any loss and responsibility caused thereby.
- ♦ During the operation of this floor scrubber, it is necessary to avoid winding long fiber substances such as ropes, corrosive chemicals, and high-temperature sundries. Otherwise, the brush may be damaged or other safety accidents might happen.
- **♦** This floor scrubber is designed to operate in dirty hard ground with various kinds of dirt.
- **♦** Any form of modification may affect its performance and service life, and even affect the safety of use, and may violate regulations. Damage caused by modification will not be covered by the warranty services of repair, replacement and refund.
- **♦** When the floor scrubber is turned on, do not put any part of the body into the rotating parts to avoid injury to the body caused by the rotation of the machine.
- **♦** The machine must be parked on a flat ground and should not be parked on a slope. Otherwise, it will cause other safety accidents.
- **♦** Disconnect the power supply of the floor scrubber before opening the hood, installing accessories, or maintenance and servicing.
- **♦** The floor scrubber should be charged in a well-ventilated place. If the battery is insufficient, the floor scrubber should be charged in time.
- **♦** When you finish your work, you should remove the key in time and keep it properly to avoid operation by unauthorized personnel.
- **♦** When the machine is shut down, all brushes and squeegees should be lifted to prolong the service life of consumables and maintain the machine.
- **♦** Do not flush the machine directly with a water cannon or high-pressure water cannon.
- **♦** Do not use the machine in a place with too much dust.
- \Rightarrow The temperature for storage and operation of the machine is required to be 32°F to 104°F (0°C to +40°C).

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

3. Control System



- 1. Speed control switch
- 2. Battery meter
- 3. Forward and backward switch
- 4. Fault indicator
- 5. Overload reset switch
- 6. Brush lifting switch
- 7. Power switch
- 8. Squeegee lift switch
- 9. Brush system fuse
- 10. Suction system fuse
- (1) Power key switch: when the key is turned to ON, the machine power is on, and when the key is turned to OFF, the power is off.
- (2) Adjust the forward and backward buttons to the forward gear (the machine will not go backward when the brush and squeegee are on the ground).
- (3) Power display: it displays the current power of the storage battery. As long as the machine is turned on, this light must be on. The power meter displays the power from right to left, that is, the rightmost indicates the highest voltage. When the voltage is as low as 10V, the brush, air suction,

and water spraying functions are stopped, but the driving function is retained. When the voltage is lower than 8V, all functions of the machine stop working.

- (4) Brush button: after pulling the brush button forward, the brush will slowly fall, and after pulling it backward, the brush will slowly rise.
- (5) Suction button: after pulling the suction button forward, the squeegee will drop and the water suction motor will start, and after pulling it backward, the squeegee will rise, and the suction motor will be off.
- (6) Horn switch: the horn switch is in the middle of the steering wheel. When it is pressed down, the horn will sound, but when it is released, it will not sound.
- (7) Emergency stop switch: press this switch to power off the control system. When the emergency stop button is pulled up, the control system will be powered on.

Warning!!

- After completing the work, the brush parts should be lifted to prevent the brushes from being deformed and worn.
- ➤ After the completion of the work, the squeegee parts should be lifted to prevent the deformation of the suction rubber strip.
- ➤ Do not park the floor scrubber on the slope.
- ➤ The machine cannot climb the slope more than 25%, and there must be no stored water in the solution tank and the recovery tank.

4. Machine Commissioning and Pre-operation Check

4.1 Pre-operation check

- 1. Check whether the appearance is clean. Note: Please do not use the machine in a flammable and explosive environment.
- 2. Check whether the storage battery wiring is in good contact to prevent short circuit fault.
- 3. Turn on the machine with the key and check whether the power is sufficient. If the power is too low, please do not continue to use the machine. Turn off the power immediately and charge the storage battery. Make sure the storage battery is fully charged before use.
- 4. Check whether the brush or micropositioner is installed correctly.
- 5. Check whether the squeegee is installed correctly (the rubber strip has been installed).
- 6. Ensure that the dirt in the recovery tank is removed.

4.2 Machine commissioning

- 4.2.1 Brush installation
- 1. Ensure that the machine is stationary.
- 2. Take out the attached brush, align the brush buckle with the flange buckle under the brush motor, rotate the brush to the left and right respectively by hand to connect the flange buckle. If the brush does not fall when both hands leave the brush, it means that the brush is connected with the flange buckle.
- 3. If a micropositioner is required, first place the fiber pad on the micropositioner, and then install in the way the same as that of brush.
- 4.2.2 Squeegee assembly installation

- 1. First lift the fixed plate assembly of the squeegee off the ground.
- 2. Unscrew the two black cross bolts in the middle of the squeegee assembly, and place the squeegee assembly in the fixed slot of the squeegee fixed plate.
- 3. Insert the suction hose into the corresponding opening of the squeegee assembly. (See the corresponding schematic diagram of the whole machine structure)
- 4. Press the suction button, put the locked squeegee assembly on the ground, check whether the rubber strip is pressed on the ground reasonably, and make appropriate adjustments.
- 4.2.3 Water injection in solution tank

The fresh water filling port is located at the left rear of the whole machine, pick up the filler cover and add fresh water into the water tank.

Note!!

When using a bucket to fill water, make sure the bucket is clean. To add detergent, please contact your local agent.

5. Machine Operation

After the check, the work can be started.

- 1. Check the water volume according to the water volume of the hose. If the water volume is insufficient, add an appropriate amount of water before starting the work;
- 2. Cover the water tank cover and ensure that the water tank cover covers properly to form a preliminary seal;
- 3. Cover the sewage pipe cover and put it in the clamp of the sewage pipe;
- 4. Adjust the water volume according to the dryness of the ground, and adjust it to the appropriate water volume;
- 5. Take the driver's seat and adjust the appropriate operating position;
- 6. Turn on the key to keep the machine powered on.
- 7. The panel indicator light is on, the forward and backward switch is turned to forward, and the speed switch is turned to the minimum speed (leftmost).
- 8. After pulling the brush and suction switch forward and putting down the squeegee and brush, the suction motor works. After stepping on the pedal switch, the brush works and the solenoid valve is opened. At this time, slowly increase the speed. The whole machine moves forward and starts to work.
- 9. To stop cleaning, first turn off the brush button, lift the brush and disconnect the solenoid valve. After moving forward for 5s, turn off the suction button until the sewage is discharged, and clean the recovery tank and squeegee. After that, stop the machine, adjust the speed to the slowest, press the key switch and pull out the key. If the power meter points to the middle position, the machine should be charged.

Recommendation!!

◆ When this floor scrubber works, it is best for it to clean at a speed of 80 to 90m per minute.

Note!!

◆ When the machine is in the reverse state, the squeegee will be automatically lifted up, and the suction motor will not work.

6. During Operation

- 1. When working on slopes or slippery ground, the machine should work at low speed and should not work on slopes more than 3°.
- 2. After the machine moves, keep it walking to avoid damaging the ground.
- 3. If the suction assembly leaves drag marks on the ground after absorbing water, please wipe the scraping strip with a rag to remove garbage. (Please clean the area to be cleaned in advance to avoid drag marks.)
- 4. If there is too much foam in the recovery tank, please pour defoaming liquid into the recovery tank in time for defoaming. (Please contact the local agent) In the process of use, you should always observe the power meter. When the voltage is as low as 20.2V, stop brush, air suction and water spray. In this way, the drive can still move forward. When the voltage is lower than 20V, all functions of the machine stop working. (Please predict in advance)
- 5. When the sewage in the recovery tank is full, the suction motor stops working. At this time, drain the sewage and fill up with clean water.

Note!!

When the sewage in the recovery tank is full, the suction motor stops working.

- 6. After Operation
- 7.1 Recovery tank drainage

After each cleaning, or before adding water to the solution tank again, the sewage in the recovery tank should be drained and the solution tank should be cleaned.

- 1. Take out the sewage pipe, pull out the cover of the sewage pipe, and put the sewage pipe into the drainage bucket or drain to start drainage.
- 2. Open the cover of the recovery tank and flush the inside of the recovery tank with clean water.
- 3. Clean the floater filter screen in the recovery tank.
- 4. Clean the water full protector in the recovery tank.

Warning!!

◆ When the solution tank is filled with water again, if the recovery tank is not drained, foam or water may enter the floater and damage the suction motor.

7.2 Solution tank drainage

After each cleaning, the solution tank should be drained and cleaned.

1. Turn on the ball valve switch next to the left rear wheel of the solution tank to drain out all the clean water in the solution tank. 2. Unscrew the transparent cover of the filter assembly to drain the clean water in the solution tank. Please clean the filter screen in the filter.

Note!!

◆ When the solution tank is filled with water again, if the recovery tank is not drained, foam or water may enter the floater and damage the suction motor.

7.3 Storage battery charging

- 1. Place the battery charger and the machine in a well-ventilated place.
- 2. Turn off the machine.
- 3. Plug the AC power cord of the charger into the power socket well grounded.
- 4. Plug the DC output of the charger into the charging port on the front column of the machine. (See

the corresponding schematic diagram of the whole machine structure)

- 5. The battery charger starts charging automatically. If the battery is fully charged, the charger will be automatically turned off.
- 6. At the end of charging, first unplug the plug connected to the AC power supply, and then unplug the output end of the charger from the machine.

Warning!!

◆ When charging the machine, you must use the original charger supplied with the machine.

8. Cleaning System

The cleaning system is a complete cleaning system composed of motor, scrubbing brush and sprinkler system. (Figure 8.1)

Warning!!

♦ Do not stay the machine at the same place to rotate the brush when starting the machine for cleaning. If the machine stays at the same place for a long time, the ground will be damaged by brushing, as shown in Schematic Diagram 8.1.



- 1. Brush motor: mainly used for driving the rotation of brush ground cleaning.
- 2. Scrubbing brush: mainly used for cleaning and decontamination of various conventional grounds.
- 3. Lifting mechanism: mainly used for the rotation of lifting and lowering of the entire cleaning system.
- 4. Water retaining rubber: prevent the second pollution caused by sewage thrown out during cleaning

8.2 Operation method

The brush lifting mechanism of this floor scrubber is provided with a push rod motor to control the lifting system with one key.

After pulling the brush button forward, the brush slowly drops. After pulling the brush button backward, the brush slowly rises. When the brush button is pressed, the brush push rod motor is started and the bush assembly is lowered. When the brush assembly drops to the ground, step on the pedal switch to start the rotation of the brush.

8.3 Check and maintenance



8.4 Maintenance mode

- 1. When the floor scrubber is stationary for a long time, the scrubbing brush should be lifted to avoid deformation of the bristles, which will affect the next cleaning effect.
- 2. During the cleaning, the metal entanglements on the bristles should be removed in time to reduce the load of the brush motor, avoid damaging the consistency of the ground and improve the overall working efficiency.
- 3. Avoid cleaning lime, cement, sulfuric acid and other objects that are easy to solidify, corrode and combust.

9. Suction System

9.1 Schematic diagram



- 1. Squeegee connecting base: it is directly connected to the lifting motor chain, and mainly plays the role of lifting the squeegee assembly.
- 2. Squeegee rotating frame: it is used as a conduction bridge for straight travel, turning and return of squeegee assembly.
- 3. Sewage suction pipe port: it is an important part of sewage suction, connecting the squeegee assembly and the recovery tank hose.
- 4. Squeegee assembly: it is an important part for sewage collection.
- 5. Supporting universal wheel: it is used for height adjustment of squeegee rubber strip. The wheel has been adjusted to the best value before factory.
- 6. Rear suction rubber strip: it is a consumable part. Please replace and maintain it as required.

9.2 Operation method

The suction lifting mechanism of this floor scrubber is provided with a push rod motor to control the lifting system with one key.

When the suction button is pressed, the suction push rod motor starts and lowers the squeegee assembly, and the suction motor starts to work.

9.3 Squeegee commissioning

With the extension of service time of squeegee, the wear of the rubber strip will have a certain impact on the suction effect. In order to completely remove the stains, the following corresponding commissioning is required.

- 1. Adjust the height of the two supporting universal wheels behind the squeegee to be the same. When the squeegee is stationary, it needs to be suspended from the ground for about 2mm to 3mm.
- 2. Rotate the four-corner handle nut until the rear rubber strip is tightly pressed against the ground.

9.4 Rubber strip replacement

The rubber strip is rectangular and should be replaced after both sides are fully used.


- 1. First, loosen the pressing plate pressed on the front and rear rubber strips.
- 2. Then remove the front and rear rubber strips.
- 3. Take out the new rubber strip required.
- 4. Install the new rubber strip in the order when the old rubber strip is removed.

Maintenance Note!!

After each floor cleaning, the squeegee assembly needs to be lifted and the rubber strip needs to be cleaned.

10. Waterway System

10.1 Schematic diagram



- 1. Solution tank: it is one of the core accessories of the machine for storing water for cleaning the ground.
- 2. Filter: it is installed on the left and right sides of the drive wheel in front of the solution tank to filter impurities in the waterway system.
- 3. Solenoid valve: one is installed on the left and right symmetrical sides of the upper part of the brush assembly respectively to control the water volume and close the water volume.
- 4. Water outlet: it is located in the middle of the brush to supply water during the brush cleaning.

10.2 Operation method

The waterway system and the cleaning system are designed to work synchronously.

While the brush is working, the solenoid valve is open. While the brush is not working, the solenoid valve is closed, and the ball valve adjusts the water volume separately.

10.3 Check and maintenance

11.2 Storage battery maintenance

The floor scrubber system is powered by 2 X 6V maintenance-free storage batteries in series, and the system voltage is 12V.

- 1. When the machine operates for a period of time, the storage battery power will drop. When the last bar of the power display meter flashes, it indicates that the power is insufficient and charge is needed in time.
- 2. When maintaining the storage battery, please wear protective gloves to avoid contact with storage battery acids.

- 3. The top of the storage battery and the electrode must be treated to prevent corrosion, that is, wipe repeatedly with a brush stained with soda water, but do not pour this solution into the battery.
- 4. Check whether the storage battery connection is worn and whether the contact parts are loose, and replace if necessary.
- 5. The power output terminal on the battery should be kept clean and dry, and there should be no sundries, dust and soil on it because it is not only extremely detrimental to the battery, but also shortens the service life of the battery and even burns the battery.

Note!!

◆ In order to make the storage battery have a long service life, the battery should be charged in time after the operation of the machine, but should not be discharged for a long time.

Warning!!

- ◆ During the use of the battery, the deep discharge battery capacity will be reduced and the service life will be shortened.
- ♦ Since the battery will release hydrogen, the battery box must be kept open during charging and away from sparks or fire sources to prevent the hydrogen released by the battery from causing danger.

[Storage Battery Maintenance Guide]

Lead-acid battery is used in this product, which is provided with the maintenance-free, servicing-free and automatic pressure relief functions; You should charge it as you use it, or immediately charge it after use and do not discharge frequently (minimum protection voltage).

1) What is short circuit, and how does it affect the battery performance?

Short circuit refers to that the positive and negative electrodes of the battery are connected to produce strong current; and the internal positive and negative electrode groups are connected. The voltage rises very slowly and remains low during charge; the electrolyte temperature rises very high and rapidly; the electrolyte density rises very slowly or hardly changes; and the terminal voltage drops rapidly during the current discharge.

2) What is over-discharge, and how does it affect the battery performance?

Over-discharge refers to the phenomenon that the electric quantity stored in the battery continues to discharge after reaching the minimum operating voltage during discharge. After the battery is over-discharged, the voltage drops sharply in a very short time. At this time, the reaction system in the whole battery is disordered. If the battery is over-discharged repeatedly, the positive electrode

will lose its activity, which will affect the service life of the battery, reduce the use time of the battery, and extend the charging time of the battery.

3) How to store the battery after use?

The battery is a sensitive product. If it is no longer used for a long time, it is best to take the battery out of the machine and put it in a dry place at normal temperature; Because the battery is placed inside the machine, and the electrical appliance and circuit board are not disconnected, continuous micro-discharge of the battery will be formed.

4) Why is the service life of the battery short?

The battery is not fully charged for a long time, and it will not be charged for a long time after being discharged. During use, the phenomenon of over-discharge often occurs. The standard charger is not selected during the charge, resulting in overcharge. The voltage between the used battery packs is different, forming a low-voltage operating state for a long time.

Product Warranty Certificate (Main Card)
